Objective

Specific requirements for this project are listed below.

- 1. Students may work individually or in a group of up to three people.
- 2. Students must create an action plan to **implement** this program, giving specific details of how this program will be started at BVW.
- 3. Students must explain how this program will be **maintained** by the school or a school group. (Note: No maintenance of the program can be through BVW or BV District staff implementation. This is a student-run program and must be maintained by students throughout the years of its implementation.)
- 4. Students must explain how the program will help **alleviate the environmental impact** of the school on the environment. Students will provide specific examples of how BVW currently is affecting the environment, as well as how their program will lessen this issue.
- 5. Students must support their ideas with cited sources that allow for clear distinctions of how their program helps the environment.
- 6. Students will create this project as a written proposal that clearly shows program funding, implementation, and benefit to the school and its environment.
 - a. Students will submit projects as a Word document to www.Turnltln.com.

*Because BVW already has a recycling program in place, students cannot create a program for recycling.
